## BLOCCADE™

The following text is taken from the label:

**Contains acrylate emulsions, fillers, wetting agent and water.**

A physical coating for protecting plant wounds against infection caused by bacteria and fungi such as *Eutypa*, *Botryosphaeria* and *Nectria* (e.g. fruit tree canker and dead arm disease).

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BLOCCADE must be applied directly to the plant wound. BLOCCADE is most effective when applied immediately after pruning.

## APPLICATION

Shake well before use. Mix one part of BLOCCADE to nine parts water. Apply BLOCCADE immediately after pruning to the wound and the area around it ensuring that the entire wound is covered. This results in an airtight shield that protects the plant from infection. BLOCCADE dries in 5 to 45 minutes. Apply BLOCCADE in dry frost-free weather.

BLOCCADE can be applied with a knapsack sprayer, orchard sprayer, or a sprayer device on the 'Felco-19' pruning shear and by brush. If applied by spraying, use a fine spray nozzle and ensure thorough coverage. For optimum results when spraying, use a non-ionic surfactant.

Diluted BLOCCADE has a limited shelf life of 24 hours.

Clean application equipment by rinsing with water.

Dried BLOCCADE can be removed with a solvent such as nail polish remover.

## STORAGE

Store BLOCCADE at room temperature and protect from frost.

## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Wear suitable protective gloves, coveralls and eye protection when handling and applying the product.

Do not breathe spray.

Do not discharge into water or soil.

**NOTE:** BLOCCADE works as a physical barrier. It is not a pesticide and does not require registration (Decision 159 standing committee DG SANCO Brussels October 2014).
